### THE WENONAH II

The Wenonah II is the first ship built in Muskoka since 1928 and Canada's newest passenger vessel. Built with the style and elegance of a 1907 passenger vessel, the Wenonah II is the second in the Wenonah, meaning "first born daughter", family of ships. The original Wenonah was the original steamship of the Muskoka Lakes Navigation Company and operated between 1866 to 1885. Accommodating up to 200 passengers, the Wenonah II features a gracious dining room and lounge, 3 decks for passenger viewing, air-conditioning and even an elevator. A consideration for hors d'oeuvres, dinner, or sightseeing cruising, the Wenonah II offers a true taste of Muskoka and a brilliant touch to any conference event.
